CAF to supply Belgrade with 30 LRVs

A contract amounting to €70 million has been signed by CAF to supply the city of Belgrade, Serbia, with LRVs to be delivered over a three year period.

These 100% low floor, metric gauge LRVs each comprise five cars with two powered bogies and a trailer bogie, giving a total length per unit of 33 metres, a width of 2.3 metres and a maximum carrying capacity of 242 passengers. The unit is unidirectional with a single driver's cab and features six access doors on one side. Power is

drawn from the overhead catenary through the pantograph at 600 Vdc, whilst the train operation and passenger information systems use cutting-edge technology.

These units are based on the URBOS, a new LRV family developed by CAF with the experience acquired over the last few years in projects such as those for Bilbao, Sevilla, Malaga, Vitoria, Antalya (Turkey), Edinburgh, Zaragoza and Houston.
